All New Exterior Styling

The Majestic Charter Coach features all new front and rear styling and is the name instantly recognisable as the coach with more history than any other in Australia. The exterior is finished with stretched aluminium upper side panels, aluminium segmented skirt panels, fixed aluminium wheel arch panels, fibreglass front and rear headers, a one piece fibreglass roof incorporating a gutter and fibreglass front and rear bumper bars.

Corrosion Resistant Lightweight Body

The body is manufactured from a combination of galvanised coated tubular steel and purpose designed pressed steel sections to form an integrated corrosion resistant, light weight, load sharing body module. The body structure is fully compliant to ADR 59/00 Rollover Structural requirements and ADR 68/00 Seat Anchorage requirements.

The Majestic features a 1500mm floor height to ground with flat saloon floor incorporating a ramped front section. Marine grade ply is fitted to the floor with galvanised steel protection above the wheels. Acoustic insulation fitted to the seat riser above the engine and floor hatches minimises engine and transmission noise with thermal insulation fitted to the roof to maintain climate control.

Passenger Comfort and Luxury

The Majestic affords your passengers the ultimate in comfort and luxury by providing passenger controlled light vent speaker modules centrally above each dual passenger seat, generous on-board luggage stowage, LCD television monitor and moquette fabric trim to saloon. Full through under floor bins are provided for maximum passenger luggage capacity.

Driver's Comfort Zone

A mechanical suspension driver's seat, heater demister ducted to the windscreens, door, driver's window and driver's feet and an ergonomically designed dash afford optimum driver comfort. The Majestic features large exterior mirrors incorporating spotters and roller blinds to the front windscreens and driver's window for driving ease and the spare wheel is located under the front on a winch mechanism.

Stylish yet Functional Saloon Access

The Majestic features a front hinged, pneumatically operated saloon door with lock and coach style dash. Entry to the saloon is provided by a spiral stairway for ease of passenger entry.

Passenger Viewing Platform

The body is fitted with emergency exits as required to meet ADR 44/02. Three piece flat windscreens incorporating polycarbonate upper screen, a fixed glass driver's window with vertical slider, two emergency exit roof hatches and bonded grey tint saloon windows are also fitted as standard.

Easy Engine Access

Engine access is provided by a large full body width rear engine door fitted with claw catches and grab handles and generous sized side engine and radiator access doors fitted with claw catches. Additionally floor hatches are provided in the saloon above the engine, transmission and accessories as required for improved maintenance access.



Fleet Livery The Majestic is finished with white exterior paint with black accents as standard or optioned up to a fully customised fleet livery and sign writing.
